What is the incredABLE Black Moon?

incredABLE Black Moon is a disco for and by adults with learning/intellectual disabilities and/or autism. The inclusive clubbing experience offers a unique opportunity to socialise with peers, make new friends and develop confidence within a modern, positive, fun and safe environment.

What is the age for incredABLE Black Moon?

Anyone over 18 is welcome, whatever age!

How much does the incredABLE Black Moon cost?

£5.00 Entry fee at door. Parents and carers go free. (Donations welcome though).

Who organises the incredABLE Black Moon?

incredABLE host the Armagh based Black Moon in partnership with brand owning arts venue Black Box (Belfast) as part of the We are incredABLE Project which is funded through the Big Lottery Fund. A number of young people involved in the project help run the disco on a monthly basis with support from a minimal number of staff and Black Moon volunteers.

How do I get to the incredABLE Black Moon?

Transport is **NOT** provided to or from the incredABLE Black Moon. Anyone travelling to the incredABLE Black Moon at Armagh city hotel must make their own way to and from the venue themselves.

Are Parent/Carers required to stay at the incredABLE Black Moon?

Most individuals or groups attending the Black Moon are supported by a parent or carer during the evening, however, we do appreciate that some individuals will have capacity to attend without support/assistance. In this instance Individuals **MUST** carry and be prepared to show their ID/Emergency contact upon entry.

How is the incredABLE Black Moon staffed?

The incredABLE Black Moon will be staffed by 2 members of incredABLE Staff and a minimum of 5 volunteers (including young people involved in the We are incredABLE Project). The role of the volunteer is to help create a fun, safe and positive environment but in keeping with the ethos of Black Moon it is not a supervisory role. Please note that there is **NO formal level of supervision or support at the Black Moon**. incredABLE can take **NO** responsibility for any individual attending unaccompanied or consuming access alcohol.



Is the incredABLE Black Moon suitable for my son/daughter/relative?

The incredABLE Black Moon is about recreating the experience of any disco/night club for an individual aged over 18. In this respect there are Black Moon stewards (Volunteers) who facilitate the event acting in an event management but NOT supervisory capacity.

Is there Alcohol served at the incredABLE Black Moon?

Yes, there is a bar selling alcoholic drinks as in any other over 18's disco/nightclub. Any individual consuming alcohol is required to do so responsibly.

Can large groups attend the incredABLE Black Moon?

Yes, large groups are welcome to attend the Black Moon but should contact the incredABLE office with details. Groups can telephone 028 38 872 111 or email info@incredible.org.uk

How is the incredABLE Black Moon promoted/advertised?

The Black Moon will be promoted monthly on the incredABLE Facebook Page.

How does the incredABLE Black Moon involve young people with a learning disability and/or autism?

The organisation of the incredABLE Black Moon will involve young people who are part of the We are incredABLE project. These young people will either be incredABLE Advisors (who co-design the project) or incredABLE Enterprise trainees who meet one day per week to learn job skills. A young person with a learning disability and/or autism will also be mentored by a Black Moon DJ.

I have a physical disability; can I attend the incredABLE Black Moon?

Yes, the Fringe Bar at Armagh Coty Hotel is fully accessible for Wheel Chair users.

Where does the incredABLE door/raffle money go each month?

The money generated from incredABLE Black Moon will support the development of incredABLE Enterprises. These day opportunities work with 18 – 25 years olds helping develop skills in design, product development, production, marketing and sales.

Is there Insurance cover for this event?

The incredABLE Black Moon will be insured under the organisations public liability insurance as a new venture.
